







Indianising Indian Bureaucracy /Civil Services

At the outset, it may kindly be accepted that the contents of this article may not be taken as aspersion/accusation but only suggestion.

Civil Services examinations are in existence from the British period in the 18th century onwards and Lord Cornwallis is called the Father of Indian Civil Service (ICS). Between 1848-1947 i.e. the division of India, the ICS officers ruled more than 300 million people of the country having 250 districts at that point of time. At the time of partition, the ICS were divided between India and Pakistan as per the choice of the officers.

Satyendranath Tagore was the first Indian to join the Indian Civil Service (ICS) who retired in 1894 and took the examination in London. From 1922 the examinations started to be held in Delhi. Now there are 2000 examination centers in 60 cities with thousands of coaching centers flourishing in the country.

The average age for appearing in the exam during British time period was intentionally kept as low as 22 years keeping in view of the fact that persons of Indian Origin may not find age eligibility because of late academic graduation. The post of district magistrate also called the District Collector was created in 1772 under Warren Hastings, the Governor of Bengal, the idea was to remove Indians from revenue administrations and make the British the sole controller of resources.

The ostentations attached to the post of District Collectorate still amuse the aspirants though the posting for such coveted job is not more than 4-5 years. This bureaucracy which is truly the weaving of national tapestry now was developed as devilish, diabolical, the wanton desire, the servility to absolutely unchanged desire to implement slavery into the loathe some bestiality of passion to rule the country i.e. India was the mind set of British people.

The subjects listed in the civil services examination are colonial and the syllabus of the various subjects were mostly suitable to the British regime to make in depth study and research to deal with ongoing encounter with the various sections of the human race at different geographical zones.

- 1. The syllabus, so far defined by the UPSC is Orivilian in nature and should be replaced by the theories and the thoughts pertaining to our country with small reference to contemporary international study so that the selected lot of IAS may understand the area which is to be served by them in true sense.
- 2. The subjects should be so chosen that the comprehensive knowledge and holistic approach is obtained by every selected candidate about the country and the section of society they are posted in.
- 3. The syllabus should be changed every two years with the latest happenings in the nation and the world, are incorporated so that solutions to tackle the same is designed in the mind of the new entrants in bureaucracy. This will obliterate the common cramming of the subjects in repeated attempts by the students who fail in the given chance.
- 4. The eligibility age should be increased from minimum 22 yrs to 30 yrs with the retirement age extended up to 65 yrs and every aspirant should have worked for 5 yrs in private segment so as to perceive the tough life and the flavor of siting on other side of table and the tribulations the private sector undergoes through the Govt. set up. GLIMPSES OF VEDIC GEOMETRY

The astonishing adaptability and usefulness of mathematics was rightly captured by Indian mathematician Mahavira (c. 950 BC) which he expressed as:

All three worlds, involving static and dynamic entities are governed by the science of calculations i.e. Ganita. It is the soul of all activities, worldly or spiritual. It is in the core of all art forms be it music, dance or drama, in cooking, medicine and architecture, in the art of love and poetic compositions, in the rules of logic and grammar and in many other quests. The movement of Sun, calculations of eclipses and concurrence of planets, estimation of cyclones and thunders, assessment of direction, time and position, i.e. triprasana of the moon, all these have ganita in their core. The number, the diameter and the perimeter of islands, oceans and mountains including all attributes of the inhabitants owe to mathematics.

Since the Vedic period, the first recorded evidence of mathematics Sulbasutras, dated around 800 to 500 BCE, the primary function of Indian mathematics was seen as generating rules for systematic and efficient methods of calculations. Sulbasutras deal with the measurement and construction of sacrificial altars. These give a compilation of mathematical results which were used in the designing and construction of Vedic sacrificial altars (vedi) and for the location of sacred fire (agni) which were to conform to the pre fixed requirements regarding their shapes and areas in order to be effective instruments of sacrifice. Square and circular altars were usually set up for household rituals. For public worship vedis had the shapes which were consisting of the combinations of rectangles, triangles and trapezium. More elaborate public altar had the shape of a falcon ready to take the flight with the belief that it would enable the soul of the supplicant to be able to enter the heaven. These constructions especially those of larger altars involved two geometrical hurdles. One was to find a square equal in area to two or more given squares and second was to transform other shapes such as circle, rectangle or trapezium into a square of equal area or vice versa. The overall plan involved being the concept of perpendicularity which was achieved through a smart combination of concrete geometry. In particular, principle of dissection and re-assembly was used. This method is taught in schools these days, involving perpendicularity of the line joining the centres of two intersecting circles with the line joining the two points of intersection, and also the use of the converse of "Pythagoras theorem". They were familiar with the "Pythagoras theorem", and explicit statement of the theorem is found in all the four major Sulbasutras.

After its encouraging beginning, the growth of pure geometry during the Vedic period underwent shadow. But the Indian contribution in the study of properties of cyclic quadrilateral is very significant. Ancient Indian mathematician Brahmgupta (b. 598 CE) furnished accurate results for the area and diagonals of cyclic quadrilaterals in Brahmsphuta-siddantha. Around 1000 years later in 14th century Narayana Pandit in his Ganitakaumudi, in 15th century Paramesvara in his Lilavatibhasya and Jysthadeva in Yuktibhasa in 16th century provided notable refinements.

The astronomer Galileo Galilei rightly observed in 1623 that the entire universe "is written in the language of mathematics", and indeed it is remarkable the extent to which science and society are governed by mathematical ideas. बादशाह अकबर ने अपने सिपाहियों की एक टुकड़ी को तुलसीदास जी के पास भेजा और तुलसीदास जी को बादशाह का पैगाम सुनाया कि आप लालिकले में हाजिर हों। यह पैगाम सुन कर तुलसीदास जी ने कहा कि मैं भगवान श्रीराम का भक्त हूँ, मुझे बादशाह और लालिकले से क्या लेना–देना और लालिकले जाने के लिए साफ मना कर दिया। जब यह बात बादशाह अकबर तक पहुँची तो उन्हें बहुत बुरी लगी और बादशाह अकबर गुस्से में लालताल हो गये, और उन्होंने तुलसीदास जी को जंजीरों से जकड़ब कर लाल किला लाने का आदेश दिया। जब तुलसीदास जी जंजीरों से जकड़े लाल किला पहुंचे तो अकबर ने कहा की आप कोई करिश्माई व्यक्ति लगते हो, कोई करिश्मा करके दिखाओ। तुलसी दास ने कहा मैं तो सिर्फ भगवान श्रीराम जी का भक्त हूँ कोई जादूगर नहीं हूँ जो आपको कोई करिश्मा दिखा सकूँ। अकबर यह सुन कर आगबबूला हो गया और आदेश दिया की इनको जंजीरों से जकड़ कर काल कोठरी में डाल दिया जाये।

दूसरे दिन इसी आगरा के लालिकले पर लाखों बंदरों ने एक साथ हमला बोल दिया, पूरा किला तहस नहस कर डाला। लालिकले में त्राहि-त्राहि मच गई, तब अकबर ने बीरबल को बुला कर पूछा कि बीरबल यह क्या हो रहा है, तब बीरबल ने कहा हुजूर आप करिश्मा देखना चाहते थे तो देखिये। अकबर ने तुरंत तुलसीदास जी को कल कोठरी से निकलवाया। और जंजीरे खोल दी गई। तुलसीदास जी ने बीरबल से कहा मुझे बिना अपराध के सजा मिली है।

मैंने काल कोठरी में भगवान श्रीराम और हनुमान जी का स्मरण किया, मैं रोता जा रहा था। और रोते-रोते मेरे हाथ अपने आप कुछ लिख रहे थे। यह चौपाई, हनुमान जी की प्रेरणा से लिखी गई हैं। कारागार से छूटने के बाद तुलसीदास जी ने कहा जैसे हनुमान जी ने मुझे कारागार के कष्टों से छुड़वाकर मेरी सहायता की है उसी तरह जो भी व्यक्ति कष्ट में या संकट में होगा और इसका पाठ करेगा, उसके कष्ट और सारे संकट दूर होंगे। इसको हनुमान चालीसा के नाम से जाना जायेगा।


